The winter fuel payment is normally paid automatically for those who are in receipt of pension credit

If you get Pension Credit you can also get other help, such as:

- · Housing Benefit if you rent the property you live in
- Winter Fuel Payment
- Support for Mortgage Interest if you own the property you live in
- a Council Tax discount

Get help and advice

Call the Winter Fuel Payment Centre if you're not sure if you're eligible. You cannot make a claim by phone.

Veteran's bus pass:

Who is eligible?:

- A registered veteran, and
- Registered as seeking employment, and
- Claiming Universal Credit or a DWP benefit, and
- Aged 16+

You may be entitled to a free Veteran's bus

travel card, supporting you to work and seeking employment in the county/locality.

Your bus travel card allows you to travel free of charge for up to 50 journeys on local bus services in Gloucestershire. Bus travel is not possible across county boundaries.

How do I apply?

You need to attend a Jobcentre Plus to register as seeking employment. At the centre, you will need to present a veteran's ID card to a work coach to prove your eligibility. The work coach will then provide the bus travel card, along with further details.

Gloucestershire Integrated Forces Strategy (GIFS):

Pop Up Gloucester Forces Hub

2 weeks and weekends April 2025 (around 21st April Anniversary of the battle of Imjin River – Gloucestershire Regiment 1951

The Pop-Up Glos-FHub in April 2025 would include 3 sections:

- 1) Brews/Wets (Drinks), Information Library, Computer Hot Desking and linked to GCC Website. **(Volunteers needed for Meet & Greet)**
- 2) Training and Networking Conferences (Training for Civilian Organisations. (Understanding the Military Mindset). Also Armed Forces Communities learning about support resources, DWP employment groups, mental health, addiction, family support, etc.
- 3) One to one interviews with Welfare and Mental Health, etc.



We also aim to include Networking Meetings (with statutory and voluntary support organisations) for:

*Homelife - Homelessness, Budgeting, Food

* Volunteering Education, Training, and Employment (Transferring out of the military).

*Health (General & Mental Health).

Objective is to provide evidence for a permanent Gloucestershire Integrated Forces Strategy (GIFS) with Central Glos-FHUB and FHUBs in all Council Districts
